The website is a joint initiative of the Ministry of Labour, Industrial Relations and Employment and the International Organisation for Migration (IOM) and is co-funded by the European Union and the Ministry of Labour and Social Policies of Italy.

In his address at the launching ceremony, Honourable Shakeel Mohamed, Minister of Labour, Industrial Relations and Employment, made an appeal to both jobseekers and employers to make optimal use of the website as regards job opportunities on the labour market. The Minister added that jobseekers will be able to apply for jobs available at both local and international levels. The website will surely be the appropriate forum for increasing interaction between jobseekers and employers to facilitate job matching.

The Honourable Minister also mentioned the various cooperation programmes his Ministry had initiated with other countries where Mauritians can benefit from effective placement and enhanced job opportunities. In that context, several agreements have already been finalised with countries such as Qatar, Abu Dhabi, Italy, Canada and France. Moreover, he expressed his satisfaction that funds will be made available by the Ministry of Finance and Economic Development for the re-engineering of the Employment Service.
