Information regarding the selection process of the Independent Oversight Advisory Committee

The International Labour Office presents it compliments to Member States of the International Labour Organization (ILO) and has the honour to provide them with important information regarding the Independent Oversight Advisory Committee (IOAC).

The terms of reference of the IOAC require that its members be appointed by the Governing Body following a triennial tripartite selection process. This process involves the publication of a call for expressions of interest and the engagement of an external consultant, specialized in the recruitment for senior positions, to screen all applications, interview candidates deemed suitable, and prepare a shortlist of the most suitable candidates for the consideration of the selection panel comprised of Governing Body members.

The Office has now launched the advertisement for new members of the IOAC whose three-year term will start as from 1 January 2025.

A "<u>call for candidates</u>" has been posted on the ILO public website and will remain available for one month. Further dissemination of the advertisement will be done through the ILO's social media accounts on LinkedIn and X (formally Twitter), and through ACTRAV and ACT/EMP as well as ILO offices in the field, in order to ensure wide outreach to ILO constituents and the communities closely following the ILO's work.
