## Ratifications for Mauritius as at September 2022

### 52 Conventions

- Fundamental Conventions: **10 of 10**
- Governance Conventions (Priority): **2 of 4**
- Technical Conventions: **40 of 176**
- Out of **52** Conventions ratified by Mauritius, of which **39** are in force, **5** Conventions have been denounced; **8** instruments abrogated; **none** have been ratified in the past 12 months.
