THE EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 93 of the Employment Relations Act

- **1.** These regulations may be cited as the Export Enterprises (Remuneration) (Amendment) Regulations 2025.
- **2.** In these regulations
 - "principal regulations" means the Export Enterprises (Remuneration) Regulations 2019.
- 3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is amended
 - (a) in paragraph (1)(b), by deleting the words "Second Schedule" and replacing them by the words "Second and Third Schedules";
 - (b) by inserting, after paragraph (3G), the following new paragraph
 - (3H) Subject to regulation 4, every employee shall
 - (a) for the period starting on 1 July 2024 and ending on 31 December 2024, be remunerated at the rates specified in the Second Schedule;
 - (b) for the period starting on 1 January 2025 and ending on 31 December 2025, be remunerated at the rates specified in the Third Schedule.

- **4.** Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the following regulation
 - **4.** For the purpose of paragraphs 2, 6 and 7 of the First Schedule, the basic wage of the employee
 - (a) specified in Part II of the Second Schedule shall, for the period starting on 1 July 2024 and ending on 31 December 2024, be at the rates specified in Column I of the Schedule or the wage agreed between an employer and his employee, whichever is higher;
 - (b) specified in Part II of the Third Schedule shall, for the period starting on 1 January 2025 and ending on 31 December 2025, be at the rates specified in Column I of the Schedule or the wage agreed between an employer and his employee, whichever is higher.
- **5.** Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (a)(ii), by deleting the words "Second Schedule" and replacing them by the words "Second and Third Schedules".
- **6.** The First Schedule to the principal regulations is amended, in paragraphs 6 and 7, by deleting the words "Second Schedule" and replacing them by the words "Second and Third Schedules".
- 7. The principal regulations are amended by adding the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- **8.** These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 2025.
