

Government Notice No. 101 of 2024

THE WORKERS' RIGHTS ACT 2019

Regulations made by the Minister under section 124 of the Workers' Rights Act 2019

1. These regulations may be cited as the Workers' Rights (Social Plan) (Income Support to Workers) (Amendment) Regulations 2024.
2. In these regulations –
“principal regulations” means the Workers' Rights (Social Plan) (Income Support to Workers) Regulations 2024.
3. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, after regulations 6, the following new regulation –
 - 6A. Where a qualifying employer –
 - (a) has paid wages to any eligible worker in any month during which the trade or business of the employer was not operational; and
 - (b) has not generated any revenue or adequate revenue to pay wages of the eligible worker,
the Director-General shall refund the employer the wages he has paid to the worker, which shall be equivalent to the basic wage or salary of the worker.
4. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 April 2024.
