Regulations made by the Minister under section 80 of the Occupational Safety, Health and Welfare Act 1988

- These regulations may be cited as the Occupational Safety, Health and Welfare (First-Aid) (Amendment) Regulations 2000.
- 2. In these regulations-

"principal regulations" means the Occupational Safety, Health and Welfare (First-Aid) Regulations 1989.

- 3. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by adding immediately after item (p) the following new item.
  - (q) Sterile disposable gloves... 2 pairs /2 pairs/ 4 pairs/ 6 pairs
- 4. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by adding immediately after item (i) the following new item
  - (j) Sterile disposable gloves ... 2 pairs
