to a fine of Rs2,000/-.

Count II: Failing to send a report of an accident within seven days. Was sentenced to a

fine of Rs800/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

2<sup>nd</sup> Case: Seven Seven Co Ltd

Date case filed: 11 October 2018

Count I: Requiring employees to work in a place of work in respect of which a fire

certificate is required without such certificate being in force. Was sentenced to a

fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

3<sup>rd</sup> Case: WingFoot Company Limited

Date case filed: 13 April 2023

Count I: Failing to ensure safety, health and welfare at work of all its employees. Was

sentenced to a fine of Rs2.000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

4th Case: Nisha Neeharee Rampersand

Date case filed: 27 February 2023

Count I: Failing to attend summons. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of

Rs200/-.

5<sup>th</sup> Case: Keep Clean Ltd

Date case filed: 30 August 2022

Count I: Failing to cause a scaffold except an excluded scaffold to be erected without

holding a permit or enlisting the services of a scaffold supervisor. Was

sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/-.

Count II: Failing to ensure that no scaffold is put into use unless it has been inspected by

a scaffold supervisor upon completion of its construction. Was sentenced to a

fine of Rs2.000/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

6<sup>th</sup> Case: Beijing Construction Engineering Group Co Ltd

Date case filed: 06 March 2023

Count I: Using a scaffold erected on cantilever support without being examined by a

Registered Professional Engineer after its erection. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs800/- and cost of Rs200/-.
