1st Case: Le Coin Libanais

Date case filed: **20 July 2022**

Count I: Using a building as a lodging accommodation without holding a Lodging Accommodation Permit issued by the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Labour, Human Resource Development and Training. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

2nd Case: G.Y Construction Ltd

Date case filed: **20 July 2022**

Count I: Failing to attend at the time and place specified in a summon. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

3rd Case: LKC Global Co Ltd

Date case filed: **17 February 2022**

Count I: Operating a factory without it being registered under the Occupational Safety and Health Act 2005. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

4th Case: Pick “N” Eat Ltd

Date case filed: **18 April 2022**

Count I: Operating a factory without it being registered under the Occupational Safety and Health Act 2005. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs4,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

5th Case: Hop N Go Ltd

Date case filed: **29 March 2022**

Count I: Operating a factory without it being registered. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

6th Case: Aqua Salt Co Ltd

Date case filed: **19 August 2021**

Count I: Failing to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the safety, health and welfare at work of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

7th Case: Anahita Hotel Ltd

Date case filed: **20 February 2018**

Count I: Failing to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the safety, health and welfare at work of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs10,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

8th Case: Tayelamay & Sons Enterprise Ltd

Date case filed: **12 February 2019**

Count I: Using a building as a lodging accommodation without holding a Lodging Accommodation Permit issued by the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Labour, Human Resource Development and Training. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

9th Case: Tayelamay & Sons Enterprise Ltd

Date case filed: **12 February 2019**

Count I: Using a building as a lodging accommodation without holding a Lodging Accommodation Permit issued by the Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Labour, Human Resource Development and Training. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

10th Case: Alteo Agri Ltd

Date case filed: **27 January 2022**

Count I: Failing to notify an accident to the Director, Occupational Safety and Health by the quickest practicable means. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/-.

Count II: Failing to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the safety, health and welfare at work of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.
