Count I: Failing to send a report of an accident within seven days. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Case: Diamoda Foods Co Ltd

Date case filed: 26 May 2022

- Count I: Failing to send the original report of examination of a refrigeration plant to the Director, Occupational Safety and Health within 28 days of the completion of the examination.
- Count II: Failing to send the original report of examination of a refrigeration plant to the Director, Occupational Safety and Health within 28 days of the completion of the examination. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs6,000/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

#### 4<sup>th</sup> Case: Municipal Council of Quatre Bornes

Date case filed: 24 October 2016

- Count I: Failing to ensure the safety, health and welfare at work of all its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs20,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.
- 5<sup>th</sup> Case: Devam Balgobin v/s Casela Limited

Date case filed: 07 July 2020

Count I: Failing to ensure the safety, health and welfare at work of all its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs10,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

## 6<sup>th</sup> Case: Seven Seven Co Ltd

Date case filed: 25 October 2021

Count I: Failing to ensure that the gate provided at enclosure of liftway is fitted with an interlocking device. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

# 7<sup>th</sup> Case: Hop N Go Ltd

Date case filed: 29 March 2022

Count I: Operating a factory without it being registered. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

## 8<sup>th</sup> Case: Municipality of Port Louis

Date case filed: 27 May 2021

Count I: Failing to provide at suitable points conveniently accessible to all employees an adequate supply of wholesome drinking water. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

# 9<sup>th</sup> Case: JL Air Conditioning & Refrigeration Ltd

Date case filed: 19 February 2021

Count I: Failing to cause every opening in floors through or from which persons are liable to fall, to be adequately fenced or boarded over. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs10,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

#### 10<sup>th</sup> Case: IBL Ltd

Date case filed: 28 February 2018

- Count I: Failing to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the safety, health and welfare at work of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs10,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.
- 11<sup>th</sup> Case: ACS Ltd

Date case filed: 27 August 2015

Count I: Failing to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the safety, health and welfare at work of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs10,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

## 12<sup>th</sup> Case: Silca & Company Ltd

Date case filed: 06 May 2022

Count I: Using a building as a lodging accommodation for its employees without holding a Lodging Accommodation Permit. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

# 13<sup>th</sup> Case: Varindera Construction Limited

Date case filed: 26 April 2022

Count I: Causing a scaffold, except an excluded scaffold, to be erected without holding a permit or enlisting the services of a scaffold contractor. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

# 14<sup>th</sup> Case: Cargo Handling Corporation

Date case filed: 03 November 2015

Count I: Case was dismissed as the Learned Magistrate was unable to find the case for the Prosecution has been proved beyond reasonable doubt and dismissed the Information against the Accused.
