**1<sup>st</sup> Case: Denim De L'Ile Limited**Date case filed: **10 February 2023**

Count I: Failing, so far as is reasonably practicable, to ensure the safety, health and welfare at work of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs7,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Case: Louis Richard Imbe**Date case filed: **25 March 2025**

Count I: Failing to provide personal protective equipment. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Case: J & J Group Ltd**Date case filed: **27 June 2024**

Count I: Operating factory without it being registered. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**4<sup>th</sup> Case: Ramasawmy & Ramasawmy Co Ltd**Date case filed: **24 April 2025**

Count I: Causing a scaffold to be constructed without holding a Scaffold Contractor's Permit. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**5<sup>th</sup> Case: Flite m&e Services Ltd**Date case filed: **28 November 2024**

Count I: Failing to ensure that where a group of employees are collectively engaged in work at height, provide to those employees a collective fall protection system to ensure the collective safety of such employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**6<sup>th</sup> Case: OPP Contracting Ltd**Date case filed: **10 December 2018**

Count I: Requiring an employee to work in any premises in respect of which a fire certificate is required without such certificate being in force. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs800/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**Development Bank of Mauritius**Date case filed: **10 December 2018**

Count I: Requiring an employee to work in any premises in respect of which a fire certificate is required without such certificate being in force. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs500/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**7<sup>th</sup> Case: Super Construction Co Ltd**

Date case filed: **10 February 2025**

Count I: Contravening a prohibition imposed by a Prohibition Order. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs10,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**8<sup>th</sup> Case: Square Deal Multi-Purpose Cooperation Society Limited**

Date case filed: **10 February 2025**

Count I: Failing to ensure that the stairs or ladders are provided to enable persons to gain access from one level of the scaffold to another level. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,000/-.

Count II: Failing to ensure that the scaffold is effectively braced by means of longitudinal and transverse bracing system which extends from the base to the top of the scaffold. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,000/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

**9<sup>th</sup> Case: Square Deal Multi-Purpose Cooperation Society Limited**

Date case filed: **10 February 2025**

Count I: Failing to ensure that there is no opening in the work platform of the metal scaffold except to allow access to that work platform. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,000/-.

Count II: Failing to ensure that every side of a work platform from which a person is liable to fall more than 2 metres is provided with toe-boards and 2 or more guardrails. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,000/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

Count I: Using a building as a lodging accommodation for its employee without holding a Lodging Accommodation Permit. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

Count I: Failing to forward a written record of proceedings of the safety and health committee meeting within 10 days. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,000/-.

Count III: Failing to ensure that every side of a work platform from which a person is liable to fall more than 2 metres is provide with toe-boards and 2 or more guardrails. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,600/- and cost of Rs200/- for the three counts.

Count I: Failing to send the original report of the result of examination of goods lift. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs500/-.

Count II: Failing to send the original report of the result of examination of passenger lift. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs500/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

**24<sup>th</sup> Case: Pearle Beach Hotel Ltd**
