4th Case: Water Sports Village Ltd

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs10,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

12th Case: Tamak Textiles Ltd

Count I: Failing to obtain a Lodging Accommodation Permit. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs10,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

13th Case: Gokhool Engineering Co Ltd

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs18,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

14th Case: Super Construction Ltd

Count I: Using a building as lodging accommodation without holding a Lodging Accommodation Permit. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs4,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

15th Case: Food & Agricultural Research & Extension Institute

Count I: Failing to appoint a Safety and Health Officer on a full-time basis. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

16th Case: Laxmanbhai & Co. (Mauritius) Ltd

Count I: Failing to carry out a fire drill. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,200/-.

Count II: Failing to hold a Safety and Health Committee every 2 months. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,200/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

17th Case: The Medine Sugar Milling Company Limited

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of its employees. Case dismissed.

18th Case: Mauritius Institute of Training and Development

Count I: Failing to carry out a fire drill. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.
