### **2<sup>nd</sup> Case: JNM**

Count I: Contravening a direction given by the Permanent Secretary. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

### **3<sup>rd</sup> Case: Xedoc Ltd**

Count I: Using a building as a lodging accommodation without holding a Lodging Accommodation Permit. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.

### **4<sup>th</sup> Case: Mashov Ltd**

Count I: Using a building as a lodging accommodation without holding a Lodging Accommodation Permit. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.

### **5<sup>th</sup> Case: Oceantex Garments Limited**

Count I: Using a building as a lodging accommodation without holding a Lodging Accommodation Permit. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.

### **6<sup>th</sup> Case: Railway Agro-Mechanical Multipurpose Co-operative Society**

Count I: Using a building as a lodging accommodation without holding a Lodging Accommodation Permit. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.

### **7<sup>th</sup> Case: Compagnie de Gros Caillous Limitee**

Count I: Failing to provide appropriate accommodation for personal protective equipment when not in use. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.

### **8<sup>th</sup> Case: Denim de L'Ile Limited**

Count I: Failing to ensure safety at work of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs8,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.
