**1<sup>st</sup> Case: Bodecor Limited**

Count I: Requiring employees to work in a place of work in respect of which a fire certificate is required without such certificate being in force. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs5,000/-.

Count II: Failing to carry out a fire drill at least once a year at its place of work requiring a Fire Certificate. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Case: Keep Clean Ltd**

Count I: Contravening a prohibition imposed by a Prohibition Order. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs4,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.
