The Minister of Labour and Industrial Relations, Honourable Muhammed Reza Cassam Uteem, delivered one clear message to every worker and employer in Mauritius mentioning clearly that the rules are there and they exist to protect you, and they will be enforced.

From the renewal of the "**Nou Travay Nou Lavenir**" programme with the **MBC**, to the hard conversations about workers' rights, employment, and the future of work.

Here's the message conveyed by the Minister and what to expect in the emissions to follow:

- **Your rights at work** - Leave entitlements, overtime rates, shift work, maternity leave, Sunday regulations. You need to know your rights.
- **Employer accountability** - Safety at work is not optional. Physical and psychological wellbeing of employees is a legal obligation.
- **Youth unemployment** - The skills mismatch is real. Training schemes and internships are being mobilised to ensure our young people are employable and ready with the right set of skills.
- **Women in the workforce** - Because an inclusive economy is a stronger economy. Several schemes are here to help women in businesses from Gender Equality and SME to provide these women with more support.
- **Persons with disabilities** - No one needs to be left behind. Support programmes and training are in place, as well as work placements, to give everyone equal opportunity in our workforce.
- **50,000+ foreign workers** - Regulations around licensed recruitment agencies are being tightened. The integrity of our labour market is non-negotiable.
- **Digitalisation & AI** - The world of work is changing fast. Upskilling is the answer and the Ministry is acting on it.

● **New digital job platform** - Job seekers can now access opportunities directly via QR code through **mauritiusjobs.govmu.org** - finding work has been made simpler.
