## **THE QUARANTINE ACT 2020**

### **Regulations made by the Minister under section 13 of the Quarantine Act 2020**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Consolidated COVID-19 (Amendment No. 3) Regulations 2022.
2. In these regulations –  
“principal regulations” means the Consolidated COVID-19 Regulations 2021.
3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new definitions –  
“booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine” means, in the case of a person who has been vaccinated with –
  - (a) one dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine, an additional dose of any other COVID-19 vaccine to that of the one dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine; or
  - (b) two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine, other than the 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine referred to in paragraph (a), an additional dose of any other COVID-19 vaccine to that of the 2 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine;“fully vaccinated with booster dose” –
  - (a) means a person who is vaccinated with a booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine, provided that the booster dose is administered not later than 6 months after the administration of the first dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine or second dose of any other COVID-19 vaccine, as the case may be; and

- (b) includes –
  - (i) includes a person who has, further to being tested as being infected with COVID-19, recovered therefrom and has, between 40 days and 6 months after the date of being tested as such, been administered with a dose of COVID-19 vaccine; or
  - (ii) a person certified as such by at least 2 Government medical practitioners designated by the Minister;
- 4. The principal regulations are amended by revoking regulation 9.
- 5. Regulation 13 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (1)(a)(i)(A), by deleting the words “vaccinated with at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine” and replacing them by the words “fully vaccinated with booster dose”.
- 6. Regulation 24 of the principal regulations is amended, in paragraph (2) –
  - (a) in subparagraph (a)(i), by deleting the words “vaccinated with a COVID-19 vaccine” and replacing them by the words “fully vaccinated with booster dose”;
  - (b) in subparagraph (b)(i), by deleting the words “vaccinated with a COVID-19 vaccine” and replacing them by the words “fully vaccinated with booster dose”.
- 7. The Consolidated COVID-19 (Amendment No. 5) Regulations 2021 are revoked.
- 8. These regulations shall come into operation on 19 February 2022.
