

Occupational Safety, Health and Welfare (First-Aid) (Amendment) Regulations 2000

GN No. 71 of 2000

THE OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE ACT 1988

Regulations made by the Minister under section 80 of the Occupational Safety, Health and Welfare Act 1988

1. These regulations may be cited as the Occupational Safety, Health and Welfare (First-Aid) (Amendment) Regulations 2000.
2. In these regulations-

"principal regulations" means the Occupational Safety, Health and Welfare (First-Aid) Regulations 1989.
3. The First Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by adding immediately after item (p) the following new item.

(q) Sterile disposable gloves... 2 pairs /2 pairs/ 4 pairs/ 6 pairs
4. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by adding immediately after item (i) the following new item

(j) Sterile disposable gloves ... 2 pairs

Every first-aid box or similar container shall contain the numbers of each item specified below depending on the number of employees, set out below -

1. The contents of every travelling first-aid kit shall be as follows-

Item	Quantity
(a) Individually wrapped adhesive dressings	6
(b) Medium sized sterile unmedicated dressings (approximately 10 cm x 8 cm)	1
(c) Triangular bandage	1
(d) Sterile covering for serious wounds	1
(e) Sterile eye pad with attachment	1
(f) Safety pins	6
(g) Cotton wool in balls or packs	100grammes
(h) Sterile gauze squares	1 pack
(i) Scissors with blunt ends	1
