**1<sup>st</sup> Case: Triolet Bus Service Ltd**

Count I: Failing to notify an accident. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,200/-.

Count II: Failing to send to the Director, Occupational Safety and Health a report of the accident. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,200/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Case: Beijing Zhuzong Group Co Ltd**

Count I: Contravened a direction given by the Permanent Secretary. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Case: Beesamduth Bheekhun**

Count I: Failing to make a risk assessment. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**4<sup>th</sup> Case: Fortress Marketing Ltd**

Count I: Failing to establish a Safety and Health Committee. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,200/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**5<sup>th</sup> Case: IHEML**

Count I: Failing to carry out a fire drill. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**6<sup>th</sup> Case: Krish Garuda Ent Ltd**

Count I: Failing to cause open sides to be fenced. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/-.

Count II: Failing to cause opening in stairway to be fenced. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

**7<sup>th</sup> Case: Sen & Ken Mexicon Ltd**

Count I: Operating a factory without it being registered. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,200/-.

Count II: Failing to make risk assessment. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,200/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

**8<sup>th</sup> Case: Executop Ltd**

Count I: Failing to review risk assessment. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,200/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**9<sup>th</sup> Case: Soc Canarapen Freres & Cie Ltd**

Count I: Failing to make risk assessment. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,200/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**10<sup>th</sup> Case: Mehrab Const Co Ltd**

Count I: Failing to ensure that scaffold platform does not have any opening. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/-.

Count II: Failing to provide guard rails to scaffold platform. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.
