## 1<sup>st</sup> Case: Ceridian Ltd

Count I: Failing to employ a Safety and Health Officer. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Case: Apollon Construction Ltd

- Count I: Failing to cause plank of scaffold platform to rest on 3 supports. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.
- Count II: Failing to cause platform to be provided with guardrails. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs5,000/-

#### 3<sup>rd</sup> Case: SSB Ltd

- Count I: Failing to notify accident. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs2,000/- .
- Count II: Failing to submit report. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

#### 4<sup>th</sup> Case: Jean Claude Agathe

Count I: Failing to provide a system of work that is safe. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs30,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

#### 5<sup>th</sup> Case: Eurolux Ltd

- Count I: Failing to examine a lift. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs4,000/- and cost of Rs300/-.
- Count II: Failing to cause liftway to be protected by substantial enclosure fitted with gates. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs6,000/-.

Count III: Failing to ensure gate of goodslift is fitted with efficient interlocking device. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs6,000/-.

### 6<sup>th</sup> Case: Beau Bebe Ltd

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of employees. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs8,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

## 7<sup>th</sup> Case: New Mauritius Hotels Limited (Shandrani Resport & Spa)

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of employees. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.
