Count I: Failing to ensure safety, health and welfare of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs12,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

2nd Case: EPI Ltd

Count I: Failing to ensure safety, health and welfare of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs8,000/-.

Count II: Failing to notify accident. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/-.

Count III: Failing to submit report of accident. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of Rs200/- for the three counts.
