**1<sup>st</sup> Case: Azur Station Ltd**

**2<sup>nd</sup> Case: District Council of Savanne**

Count I: Failing to ensure safety, health and welfare at work of all its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs8,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.
