1st Case: Nundanee Fit-Out & Interiors Ltd

Count I: Failing to ensure safety, health and welfare of its employees. Was sentenced to

a fine of Rs8,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

2nd Case: Jyoti's Clinic Ltd

Count I: Permitting employees to work in a place of work in respect of which a fire

certificate was required without such certificate being in force. Was sentenced to

a fine of Rs2,000/-.

Count II: Failing to make a risk assessment in respect of its undertaking. Was sentenced

to a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

3rd Case: Kadir Nadim

Count I: Failing to cause the scaffold to be effectively and securely braced to ensure

stability in all directions. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/-.

Count II: Failing to ensure that the scaffold in use at its construction site is of good

construction. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/-.

Count III: Failing to ensure that suitable catch platform or net is erected above any

entrance where persons work or regularly pass. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs1,500/- and cost of Rs200/- for the three counts.

4th Case: Topnotch Ltd

Count I: Failing to cause the scaffold to be effectively and securely braced to ensure

stability in all directions. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/-.

Count II: Allowing employees to work at height without providing appropriate fall

protection system to that employee. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/- and

cost of Rs100/- for both counts.

5th Case: Joachim Andrianarijaona

Count I: Failing to cause the open sides on third floor from which persons are liable to fall

to be adequately fenced. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of

Rs100/-.

6th Case: EPI Contracting & Co Ltd

Count I: Failing to cause opening in floor of building from which persons are liable to fall

to be adequately fenced. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs1,500/- and cost of

Rs100/-.

7th Case: Multi Dimension Fashion Ltd

Count I: Failing to carry out a fire drill at least once a year at its place of work according

to an established fire and emergency plan approved by the fire services. Was

sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

8th Case: Cogir Ltd

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of employees. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs10,000/- and cost of Rs300/-.

9th Case: Seven Seven Co Ltd

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of employees. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs8,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.

10th Case: Texto Ltd

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of employees. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs300/-.

11th Case: Goldox Ltd

Count I: Failing to ensure that platform is boarded to prevent tools and materials from

falling. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,500/-.

Count II: Failing to provide guardrail to scaffold platform. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs2,500/-.

Count III: Caused scaffold to be used without being braced. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs2.500/- and cost of Rs200/- for the three counts.

12th Case: Blue Mountain Contracting Ltd

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of persons not in its employment. Was

sentenced to a fine of Rs2,500/-.

Count II: Failing to cause open sides of building to be fenced. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs1,500/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

13th Case: Jet's Villa Ltd

Count I: Failing to cause open sides of building to be fenced. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs2,000/-.
