Count I: Failing to ensure, so far as is reasonably practicable, the safety, health and welfare at work of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Case: Beemanique Stone Crusher Ltd**

Date case filed: **29 March 2022**

Count I: Failing to forward written record of proceedings of Safety and Health Committee meeting within 10 days of the meeting to the Director, Occupational Safety and Health. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs7,000/-.

Count II: Failing to forward written record of proceedings of Safety and Health Committee meeting within 10 days of the meeting to the Director, Occupational Safety and Health. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs7,000/-.

Count III: Failing to forward written record of proceedings of Safety and Health Committee meeting within 10 days of the meeting to the Director, Occupational Safety and Health. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs7,000/- and cost of Rs200/- for the three counts.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Case: Beemanique Stone Crusher Ltd**

Date case filed: **29 March 2022**

Count I: Failing to securely fence dangerous part of a machinery. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs7,000/-.
