1st Case: Larsen & Toubro Limited

Count I: Failing to ensure that scaffold is effectively braced. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

2nd Case: West Lagoon Ltd

Count I: Failing to ensure safety at work of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs8,500/-.

Count II: Failing to notify Director, Occupational Safety and Health of an accident by

quickest practicable means. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/-.

Count III: Failing to send a report of an accident to Director, Occupational Safety and

Health within 7 days. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2.000/- and cost of Rs200/-

for the three counts.

3rd Case: Abdool Bashir Rengony

Count I: Failing to ensure that scaffold is effectively braced. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs5,000/-.

Count II: Failing to ensure that any work platform does not have any opening except to

have access to that work platform. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs5,000/-.

Count III: Failing to ensure that every side of work platform is provided with guardrails.

Was sentenced to a fine of Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/- for the three counts.

4th Case: Abdool Bashir Rengony

Count I: Failing to cause open sides to be adequately fenced. Was sentenced to a fine

of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

5th Case: Beijing Zhuzong Group Co Ltd

Count I: Failing to cause all sanitary conveniences to be maintained and kept clean at all

times. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs10,000/-.

Count II: Contravening a prohibition imposed by a Prohibition Order. Was sentenced to a

fine of Rs10.000/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

6th Case: Central Electricity Board

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of employees. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs10,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

Mohammad Irfane Peerally 7th Case:

Failing to ensure safety and health of employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/-. Count I:
