**1<sup>st</sup> Case: Toyota Mauritius Ltd**

Date case filed: **06 January 2023**

Count I: Failing to ensure the safety and health of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Case: Eminence Marketing Ltee**

Date case filed: **06 January 2023**

Count I: Operating a factory without it being registered under the Occupational Safety and Health Act 2005. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs800/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Case: Nidomac Ltd**

Date case filed: **15 May 2023**

Count I: No person shall use or permit a steam boiler to be use at any place of work unless it has been registered by the Permanent Secretary in accordance with the Occupational Safety and Health Act 2005. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**4<sup>th</sup> Case: Raffray Brothers Ltd**

Date case filed: **31 March 2022**

Count I: Failing to send report of accident to the Director, Occupational Safety and Health. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**5<sup>th</sup> Case: Innodis Ltd**

Date case filed: **20 December 2022**

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**6<sup>th</sup> Case: Cargo Handling Corporation Limited**

Date case filed: **30 November 2022**

Count I: Failing, so far as is reasonably practicable, to ensure the safety, health and welfare at work of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs7,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**7<sup>th</sup> Case: ESC Construction Ltd**

Date case filed: **27 February 2023**

Count I: Failing to ensure that every side of platform is provided with guardrails. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs800/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**8<sup>th</sup> Case: Tasty Meal Enterprise Ltd**

Date case filed: **27 February 2023**

Count I: Failing to hold Lodging Accommodation Permit. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs800/- and cost of Rs200/-.

**9<sup>th</sup> Case: Dakri Paper Ltd**

Date case filed: **19 March 2017**

Count I: Failing to notify an accident by the quickest practicable means. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs500/-.

Count II: Failing to send a report of an accident within seven days. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs500/- and cost of Rs200/- for both counts.

**10<sup>th</sup> Case: Dakri Paper Ltd**

Date case filed: **07 August 2021**

Count I: Failing to ensure the safety and health of its employees. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs15,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.
