### 7. <u>Prosecution</u>

(i) Judgement was delivered in 4 cases for a total of 5 counts: -

### 1<sup>st</sup> Case: Bissoon Coach Work Ltd

Count I: Using a building as a lodging accommodation without holding a Lodging Accommodation. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Case: Enterprise Georges Chow Mein Limited

Count I: Failing to securely fence dangerous part of a machinery with a device which automatically prevents the operator from coming into contact with that part. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

### 3<sup>rd</sup> Case: China State Construction Engineering Corporation Limited

- Count I: Failing to provide riving knife behind the saw blade of circular sawing machine. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/-.
- Count II: Failing to cause part of the saw blade of circular sawing machine to be guarded with a strong and easily adjustable guard. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,000/- and cost of Rs200/- for both cases.

## 4<sup>th</sup> Case: Solid Waste Recycling Ltd

Count I: Requiring employees to work in premises requiring a fire certificate without such certificate being in force. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs3,500/- and cost of Rs200/-.
