Count I: Failing to cause open side of staircase leading from ground floor to first floor to

be adequately fenced. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs2,000/-.

Count II: Failing to cause open side of staircase leading from first floor to second floor to

be adequately fenced. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs2,000/-.

Count III: Failing to cause opening on the third floor (lift shaft) through which persons were

liable to fall to be adequately fenced. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs2,000/-

and cost of Rs200/- for the three counts.
