7th Case: R. Cader Bayah

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of employees. Was sentenced to pay a fine

of Rs15,000/-.

Count II: Failing to send report of accident. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs2,000/-.

Count III: Failing to notify accident. Was sentenced to pay a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of

Rs200/- for the three counts.

8th Case: JP & R Exports Ltd

Count I: Failing to ensure safety and health of employees. Was sentenced to pay a fine

of Rs15,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

9th Case: Chang Cheng Esquares

Count I: Failing to cause open sides of building to be fenced. Was sentenced to pay a

fine of Rs5,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.
