Rs2,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

3rd Case: A&W Wong Ltd

Count I Failing to make risk assessment. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/-.

Count II: Failing to carry out a fire drill. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of

Rs200/- for both counts

4th Case: Wong Choi Wah Ah Choon

Count I: Failing to ensure that every platform of a scaffold is boarded in such a way as to

prevent tools and materials from falling through. Was sentenced to a fine of

Rs2,000/-.

Count II: Failing to ensure that every working platform is provided with substantial

guardrail. Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/-.

Count III: Failing to cause convenient access to be provided to every scaffold platform.

Was sentenced to a fine of Rs2,000/- and cost of Rs200/- for the three counts.

5th Case: Central Electricity Board

Count I: Failing to ensure safety, health and welfare of employees. Was sentenced to a

fine of Rs40,000/- and cost of Rs200/-.

6th Case: JNL Ltd

Count I: Performing work without a Job Contractor's Permit. Absolute discharge. Was

sentenced to a cost of Rs100/-.
